Accessibility Statement

Arnold NextG GmbH is committed to ensuring its website is accessible in accordance with the requirements of the German Act on Equal Opportunities for Persons with Disabilities (BGG) and the Accessible Information Technology Ordinance (BITV 2.0). These regulations implement the European Accessibility Act (EAA) and mandate compliance with harmonized standards such as EN 301 549, which is based on the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.1 Level AA-an intern...

This accessibility statement applies to the website www.arnoldnextg.de.

Status of Compliance with Accessibility Requirements

This website is partially compliant with the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.1 due to the non-conformities and exceptions described below.

Non-Accessible Content

1. Technical Limitations

- Keyboard Navigation and Focus Visibility: Some page components are not yet fully operable via keyboard, and focus indicators may not always be clearly visible. A technical revision is currently in progress.
- Form Fields: In some cases, correct programmatic labels are missing, which may affect screen reader compatibility. While placeholder texts or visual cues may be present, they are not a full substitute for accessible labeling. Form improvements are planned.
- Buttons and Links: Some buttons lack sufficient alternative text or meaningful labels. Occasionally,

broken links or unreachable pages may occur. We are actively working to resolve these issues.

- Alternative Text for Images: Due to the large number of visual elements on our website, WCAG requirements regarding alternative text may not always be fully met.

- Heading Structure: There may be occasional inconsistencies or skipped heading levels. These may occur due to the extensive content volume and the number of contributors involved.

2. Multimedia Content

Embedded videos-particularly older ones-may not include verified subtitles or audio descriptions. Subtitle quality may vary. Enhanced accessibility standards will apply to all future video content. We are working to ensure that future videos meet accessibility standards, including improved subtitle quality and quality assurance processes.

3. Content Outside the Scope of Applicable Legislation

PDF documents are not explicitly covered under WCAG 2.1 Level AA. However, Arnold NextG GmbH is committed to accessibility across all web functionalities. Some older PDF files uploaded before June 2025 have not yet been fully reviewed for accessibility and may not meet current requirements. A gradual revision process is planned.

Measures for Improvement

The website is continuously reviewed and updated. Editorial and technical teams have been progressively trained in digital accessibility to ensure that all new content meets accessibility requirements.

Statement Creation and Testing Method

This statement was created on June 23, 2025, based on an internal self-assessment conducted by the Arnold NextG web team using evaluation tools and manual testing.
